Crew centre and facilities

Crew centre

Crew showers and toilets

Main centre for toilets and showers is in the main parking lot of Noblessner Marina behind the Kai Art Centre (address Peetri 12, see map).

Smaller centre is in the Old City Harbour at the very far end of the

quay 17. Cruise Terminal has toilets inside as well.

Both centres are open 24 hours. Security guard checks for wristbands! Bring your own towel and soap.

NB! Due to limited possibilities, please plan your showering times and avoid going to the centres all together (right before the events, etc.) as there will be long queues then and possible shortage of warm water.

Crew laundry facilities

Laundry is collected on the day of arrival on July 11. The laundry will be washed as a service and returned by the morning of July 13 to the collection point. Bags with a name tag for laundry are given to every vessel by your LO. Laundry drop-off and pickup (find the signs!) spots are:

Friday, 12 July

Crew Parade

When: 16:00 (Meet up and muster at 15:30!)

Location: Towers' Square (Tornide väljak) near the Old Town. See map: Crew Parade
The parade (1,6 km) starts from Towers' Square, moves next to the railroad station Balti jaam to Vana-Kalamaja street and then along Kalaranna street to Lennusadam. The finish is in front of the main stage. Bring outfits and props that make the parade fun for both crew and spectators.

Transport arrangements: Free red double-decker buses are going from Noblessner Marina (in front of PROTO) to the starting point of the parade on Towers' Square at 14:30 and 15:00 and also from the Cruise Terminal in the Old City Harbour (in front of the main gate) to the starting point of the parade on Towers' Square at 14:30 and 15:00. Towers' Square is 25 minutes walk from the Cruise Terminal and

21 minutes walk from the Seaplane Harbour.

Tip! Make your own costumes at the Crew Parade Costume Workshop on Thursday and Friday before the parade.

Prize-Giving Ceremony

Location: Seaplane Harbour, Main Stage

The prize-giving ceremony will begin immediately after the crew parade. Additional special awards include Social Media prize and UNESCO City of Music prize.

Crew Party

When: 19:00–00:00

Location: Nobel hall (PROTO) at Noblessner Marina, address: Peetri 10 (see map)
Come, let's enjoy delicious food and drinks, live music, and good company. At the party, we will also be presenting some sports competition awards in team and individual categories.

Admission for crew members wearing TSR wristband and the Crew Party wristband provided by STI only. Beverages will be served according to the colour of your wristband. Only drinks served/bought on the premises are allowed. You may buy extra beverages and pay by credit card.

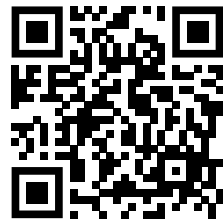

11:00–12:15 Open House tour: Venture behind the closed doors of Linnahall (30 spaces)

On this unique tour organised by the Estonian Centre for Architecture, architecture enthusiasts get a sneak peek behind the long-shut doors of the legendary Linnahall Concert Hall in Tallinn. Linnahall belongs to an ensemble of facilities built to host the Tallinn sailing regatta of the XXII Moscow Olympics in 1980. In 2020, Linnahall made waves as one of the locations where Christopher Nolan filmed his motion picture TENET.

Please dress for the tour according to weather (the tour also takes you to the rooftop of Linnahall, where it can be windy or rainy, depending on the day). The building is not heated and is rather cold/chill all around the year.

Meeting point: Linnahall (Sadama 1), in front of the Linnahall stairs (left side)

11:00–12:00 Guided tour in Kalamaja Museum (25 spaces)

The excursion introduces the permanent exhibition of the museum "A Village in the Middle of the City". Stories about Kalamaja" speaks of the life of the area through six personas characteristic to Kalamaja: a man of Kalamaja, a child of Kalamaja, a parent of Kalamaja, a life artist of Kalamaja and an animal of Kalamaja. These characters are a summary of different times and eras and tell the story from the Middle Ages to today. Walking through the

museum will open the stories of the houses of the area together with the local people: the visitor is welcomed in the cellar, corridor, garage, living room, but you can find exhibitions in the toilet as well.

11:00–12:20 Guided tour in Kiek in de Kõk Fortification Museum (25 spaces)

During the excursion, we will get to know the bastion passages built in the 17th century, the exposition, the history of the passages, and the display of the museum's inscription stone collections.

Location: Komandandi tee 2

July 13

10:00–13:00 Tallinn Private City Tour (30 spaces)

See the best sites of both medieval and modern Tallinn in a few hours. Tallinn city sightseeing tour by a private bus (1,5 hours), Old Town walking tour (1,5 hours). The tour will end at the Town Hall Square.

Meeting point: guide will meet you outside of the Seaplane Harbour museum's entrance with a sign 'Nordic Experience'.

11:00–12:30 Open House tour: A tailored tour of the Patarei Sea Fortress (30 spaces)

Visit the notorious architectural pearl Patarei before it's closed for reconstruction and its eery interior will be lost forever. On the exclusive tour organised by Estonian Centre for Architecture, we will unlock the heavy doors to the Kalaranna Fortress and its maze-like corridors. As a bonus, you will see places

that have never been open to the public.

We advise to dress according to the weather – inside the Patarei Sea Fortress it's rather cool at any season, it is also quite windy at the seaside. Please wear appropriate shoes (suitable for moving on uneven surfaces and on 'rubble'). As there are many 'dark corners' in the sea fortress, we advise you bring along your own flashlights/torches (if you have).

Meeting point: the chimney next to Patarei Sea Fortress (Kalaranna 28).

11:00–12:00 Guided tour in Kalamaja Museum (25 spaces)

The excursion introduces the permanent exhibition of the museum "A Village in the Middle of the City". Stories about Kalamaja" speaks of the life of the area through six personas characteristic to Kalamaja: a man of Kalamaja, a child of Kalamaja, a parent of Kalamaja, a life artist of Kalamaja and an animal of Kalamaja. 13:00–13:45 Guided tour in the Town Hall (30 spaces)
Tallinn Town Hall is the oldest surviving town hall in Northern Europe. First mentioned in 1322, the building history of the Town Hall goes back to the 13th century. The management of the city worked in the Town Hall until 1970. Today the Town Hall functions as the ceremonial building of the city government.

Meeting point: in front of the main door (Raekoja plats 1)

Tallinn Old Town is the oldest part of Tallinn. Old Town of Tallinn has managed to wholly preserve its structure of medieval and Hanseatic origin. It represents an exceptionally intact 13th century city plan. Since 1997, the area has been registered in the UNESCO World Heritage List. The old town is bordered by the Walls of Tallinn.

Telliskivi Creative City is located in the former industrial complex of Tallinn, which houses galleries, small shops, various creative companies, start-ups, and restaurants.

In the heart of the creative city is the internationally renowned Fotografiska Tallinn Photography Museum, Juhan Kuus Documentary Photo Centre, Sõltumatu Tantsu Lava theatre and a contemporary dance platform, LaMuu Ice Cream Factory, the Erinevate Tubade Klubi venue, and several other creative companies. The Mystery of Banksy – A Genius Mind / Time Slot, an unauthorized exhibition will be open in July at Telliskivi M building.

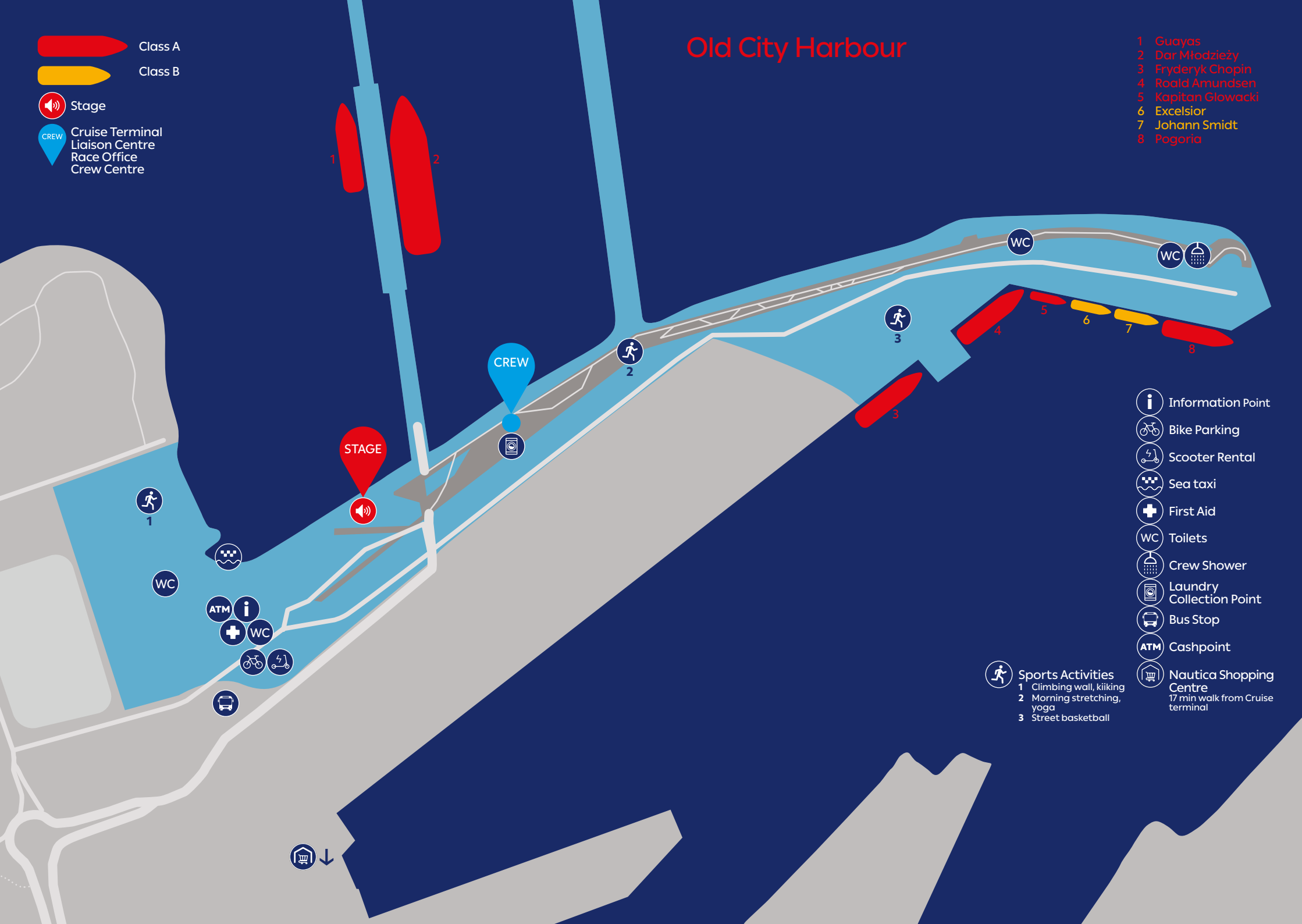
